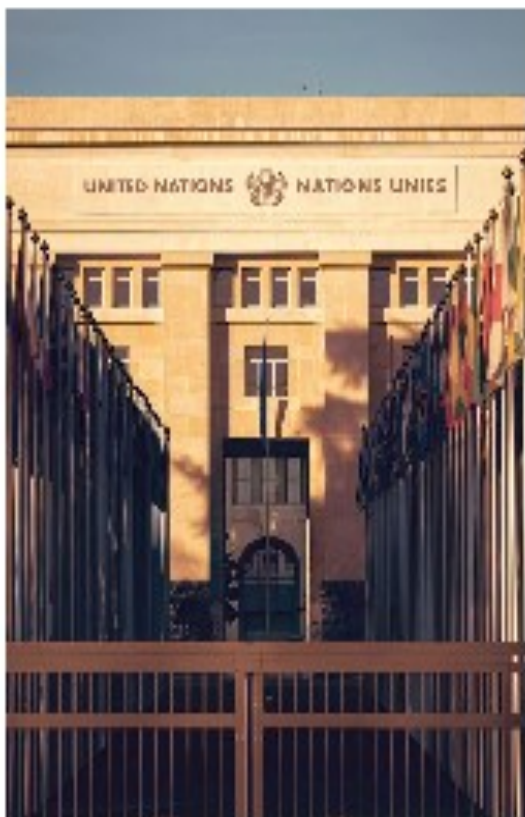
A new board for a new triennium!

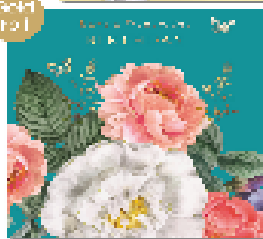
Mothers' Union represented at the Lambeth Awards
